- Letter of recommendation from the applicant's school outlining extra-curricular activities
- Job Letter from Mother and Father's Employer stating annual Salary
- Letter of Acceptance/Entrance exam results from participating Private High School
- Essay of 100 words or less (must be done by the applicant) on "Why he/she should be awarded the Carleton Williams Caribbean Bottling Company Scholarship"
- A passport photo

REQUIREMENTS OF APPLICANTS:

Successful candidates must be:

- Bahamian citizen
- Graduating from 6th grade at a Bahamian Government Primary School in New Providence or Grand Bahama (for New Providence only students from Garvin Tynes Primary* will be considered) during the intake year.
- In need of financial assistance
- Student must have a 3.0 GPA or above
- Student must show evidence of involvement in community and extra-curricular activities
- Student must be able to attend the required candidate interviews
